For and on behalf of Managing Director JKSRTC, applications are invited from the registered Load Transport Contractors for their registration as empanelled vendors for transportation of left-over load carriage demand for a period of five years in the first phase (2019-23). The applications should reach to the office of undersigned by or before 26th of March-2019. No application/representation shall be entertained after expiry of last date of receipt. Details terms and conditions of the contract can be had from the office of General Manager (Load) JKSRTC, M.A.Road Srinagar and Traffic Manager (Load) JKSRTC, Narwal, Jammu during the office hours or may be down-loaded from office website www.jksrtc.co.in of JKSRTC.

In exercise of powers conferred under RTC Act 1950 Section 19 Sub section 2 (j) and as approved by the Chairman-JKSRTC (Hon'ble Transport Minister). The empanelment of CHT Contractors has become inevitable and thus terms and conditions of empanelment for 5 years in the first instance (2018-19) w.e.f. 05.03.2019 and are devised as under:-

- 1/ The registration of CHT contractor to work with JKSRTC as sub-contractors will be for a period of 5 years (2018-2022) in the first instance w.e.f. issuance of registration/empanelment certificate.
- 2/ The CHT contractor to be registered/empanelled with JKSRTC should have heavy commercial vehicles minimum pay load of 09 MTS or above. the vehicles should be registered in the name of firm with valid documentary proof.
- 3/ The CHT contractor should have 50 trucks attached with his fleet and the truck No's should be reflected on Affidavit duly attested by Notary.
- 4/ Hard copies of the relevant Registration certificate/Route permit/Certificate of attachment.
- 5/ The CHT contractors will be categorized as below:-
 - a) Contractor having a fleet of 15 to 30 trucks will be "B" category.
 - b) Contractor having fleet above 30 trucks will be "A" category.
 - c) Contractor having a fleet less than 15 trucks will not be considered.
- 6/ The CHT contractor of "A" category will have to deposit EMD to the extent of Rs.40.00 lacs in the shape of CDR/FDR pledge to FA&CAO JKSRTC and 3% security deposit shall be deducted from the bills of the contractor.
- 7/ The CHT contractor of "B" category shall deposit EMD to the extent of Rs.25.00 lakhs in the shape of CDR/FDR pledged to FA&CAO JKSRTC. Besides, 6% Security deposit shall be deducted from bills of contractor. The contractor who does not have work experience shall deposit Rs. 30.00 lakhs instead of Rs. 25.00 lacs in the shape of CDR/FDR pledged to FA&CAO JKSRTC and 6% Security deposit shall be deducted from bills of contractor.

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- 8/ The CHT contractor thus registered with JKSRTC for carrying out left over demand will not be entitled to participate in FCS & CA department or any other department /PSU where under Corporation participates in tendering process till they remain registered with JKSRTC or otherwise seek NOC from Corporation.
- 9/ The CHT contractor will not indulge in any kind of litigation involving the interests of the Corporation. The contractor will have to furnish an affidavit to this effect along with other documents.
- 10/ The CHT contractor must be duly registered with the relevant authority of the state of Jammu and Kashmir. The CHT contractor should be in possession of valid Motor Transport Licence applicable under section 127(2) of J&K Motor vehicle rules.
- 11/ The CHT contractor should possess 4-years work experience in the field of handling and transportation of goods during last 4 years. The work done experience certificate should be under single or multiple contract and must have been obtained from Central/State Government/Undertaking/Corporation /Autonomous bodies/Municipal Bodies/Reputed Private companies.
- 12/ In case the empanelled CHT contractor/s fails of provide the demanded number of vehicles, the FDR/EMD/Security Deposit of the firm shall be forfeited, besides risk and cost shall be imposed.
- 13/ The CHT contractor will provide required No. of vehicles to the Corporation duly fitted with GPS/VTS devices as and when asked for.
- 14/ The turnover of contractor should not be less than 25.00 Crore for 4-years (exclusively on account of goods carriage through trucks). Copy of Balance sheet, Profit & Loss Account, duly audited for the last 4 years.

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- 15/ Affidavit attested by First Class Magistrate to the effect that if during the period of contract, the contractor indulges in any activity that construes as an Act unbecoming of a law abiding citizen, the contract is liable to be terminated.
- 16/ Affidavit duly attested by First Class Magistrate to the effect that the contractor or any of the partners or representatives were never black listed by any Government Department/Corporation/Autonomous Body.
- 17/ Experience certificate in the proforma prescribed shall be produced from customers stating proof of satisfactory execution and completion of contract(s) besides duly certifying nature, period of contract and value of the work handled.
- 18/ The year for the purpose of experience will be taken as financial year (1st April to 31th March).
- 19/ Registration Fee of Rs. 15000/- Non-Refundable by way of call Deposit Receipt valid at Call/Banker's cheque in favour of FA&CAO JKSRTC payable at JK Bank R.R Srinagar/Town Hall Jammu.
- 20/ The contractor shall be responsible to supply adequate and sufficient No. of trucks as demanded by the Corporation on daily basis and shall ensure that the vehicles are positioned at the different loading points as per demand of the Corporation.
- 21/ In special cases the contractor may be required at short notice to arrange vehicles at different locations and the contractor shall be bound to supply requisite quantity vehicles.

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22/ The contractor shall periodically inform in writing the registration no's and description of newly inducted vehicles in his fleet.

23/ In case of any dispute between the parties viz-a viz JKSRTC and empanelled vendor the Managing Director, JKSRTC will be the sole arbitrator and his decision shall be binding upon the parties.
